The hockey game and his parents, society and friends are inspiration to him to take of this sport and they also supported and co-operated to him.

He spent the most of his childhood days and adulthood days in the Bangalore city that allowed him to get better facilities to play and practice hockey game in his early days. He was influenced by great players like Mohammed Shaid, Zafar Iqbal and Mervin Fernandez.

FAMILY BACKGROUND:

His father Mr. C.T. Varkey was a retired Accountant, St. John's Medical College, Bangalore and mother

Mrs. Marina Varkey, She was retired Teacher, SNH Primary School, Yeshwantpur, Bangalore. He had two younger sisters. He was married to Mrs. Julie in the year 2001 and he was blessed with four kids namely Ruben, Jane, Joshna and Rose.

Education Career:

He was studied at St. Patrick's high school and passed in the year 1987 and joined for PUC at Christy College, Bangalore and passed in the year 1989. Then he did Bachelor of Arts (B.A) in the distance mode at IGNOU, Bangalore and graduated in the year 2010.

Employment Career:

He worked for the ITC, Bangalore in 1990-92 and he is currently employed as a Deputy Manger (ARB) with Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, Bangalore.

He retired from International hockey after the world cup of 2002 and continued to play for employers of B P C L till 2010 and he did coaching for the B P C L team up to 2014 at national level. He stays at E-3, Staff Quarters, St. John's Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka.

His thoughts:

P A Raphael the SAI coach who was impactful on his hockey career which he believes that led to his representation in the national team. He is extremely grateful for the support through his career "if given a chance to play a game again, I will choose hockey because it is a beautiful game to play and has given me my livelihood.

In the World Cup 2002 I felt that my performance was reduced since I was not feeling energetic and coming back after 3 years I had lost my original game.

Hockey Career:

He represented Karnataka State hockey team in the sub-junior nationals (winner) and junior nationals (2 time winner) in 1987. Earlier he started playing for SAI Bangalore in the year 1988. An excellent fast moving forward who is capable of showing the artistry of Indian Dribble, was identified to play for India from the famous Bangalore sports hostel, was selected to play for India in Atlanta Olympic Games in 1996. He was also a member of silver medal winning Indian Hockey team of Hiroshima Asian Games 1994. Apart from doing duty for India in many major International tournaments, he was a playing member of the Sydney World Cup Indian Hockey team in 1994.

Further he represented Karnataka State hockey team in the senior nationals and national games in the year 1997. He was become the captain of Karnataka State hockey team in the year 1998 for the Murugappa Gold Cup and team placed 2nd in that tournament.

In the 1999 (2nd place) and 2001 Murugappa Gold Cup he was adjudged as the 'Forward of the tournament'. Totally he played 169 international matches during his hockey career.

- He represented Indian hockey team in the Test Series: India V/s Kenya 1991 held at New Delhi, India (Winners).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Asia Cup 1993 held at Hiroshima, Japan (Silver medal).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the European Tour: Inter Continental Tournament 1993 held at Ponzan (Winners).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the European Tour: Alps Cup 1993 held at Vienna, Italy (Winners).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Asian Games 1994 held at Hiroshima, Japan (Silver medal).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the World Cup 1994 held at Sydney, Australia (5th place).
- He participated in the Test Series: India V/s Holland, India V/s Australia and India V/s South Africa 1994 held at Holland, Australia and South Africa respectively.
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Olympics 1996 held at Atlanta, USA (8th place).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Sultan Azlan Shah Cup 1996 held at Ipoh, Malaysia.
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Australian Tour: 4th Nation Tourney 1996 held at Australia.

- He represented Indian hockey team in the European Tour: 4th Nation Tourney 1996 held at Hamburg.
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Asian Games 1998 held at Bangkok, Thailand (Gold medal).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the World Cup 1998 held at Utrecht, Netherlands (9th place).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Commonwealth Games 1998 held at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia (4th place).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Indo Pak Series 1998 held at Lahore, Pakistan (Lost).
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Australian Tour: 4th Nation Tourney 1998 held at Australia.
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Champions Challenge 2001 held at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia (Gold
- He represented Indian hockey team in the Sultan Azlan Shah Cup 2001 held at Ipoh, Malaysia (5th place).
